STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE - ASA COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

Effective for Summer 2017 semester, under the section “**ASA COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS**”, a new scholarship will be available to ASA students:

SUMMER 2017 ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Description

ASA College offers an academic achievement scholarship for the Summer 2017 semester to students who meet the following criteria:

- Achieve a CGPA between 2.0 and 4.0 at the end of Spring 2017 semester;
- Enroll full time (minimum 12 credits) for the Summer 2017 semester;
- Must complete the Summer 2017 semester, otherwise scholarship will be forfeited;
- Must have no disciplinary infractions for the duration of their time at ASA.

Award Amount

Scholarships will be awarded according to the following schedule:

- Students with CGPA of 3.0-4.0 will be awarded \$1000.00;
- Students with CGPA of 2.0-2.99 will be awarded \$500.00;
- Students who successfully complete Level C ESL and begin their core requirements will be awarded \$500.00.

If approved, the award will be reflected on the Financial Aid Eligibility Notice and will be posted to the student’s account upon completion of the Summer 2017 semester.

Application Procedure

Applicant must have a completed FAFSA on file with ASA for the 2016-17 and 2017-18 award years. All Department of Education verification requirements, for both years, must be met before eligibility for the scholarship will be considered.

Applicant must wait until all grades are posted for the Spring 2017 semester and their CGPA can be calculated. In order to be considered, applicants must complete the scholarship application as well as a 200 word essay, describing why they have chosen their current program and what their plans are after they graduate. Scholarship eligibility will be determined by the Scholarship Committee.
