

## STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE - ASA COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

**Effective Summer 2017 semester**, under the section “**ASA COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS**”, Transfer Student Scholarship should read as follows:

### TRANSFER STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

*Description*

ASA College has established a scholarship to be awarded to all eligible transfer students.

- Student must complete a free Application for Financial Aid (FAFSA) and receive a valid Institutional Student Information Record (ISIR);
- Student must be enrolled into a degree program;
- Student must be enrolled full time;
- Student must complete the semester in order to receive the scholarship amount for that semester.
- Student must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 and consecutive term enrollment as a full-time student in order to maintain eligibility for the scholarship.

The award will be reflected on the Financial Aid Eligibility Notice and will be posted to the student’s account upon successful completion of the semester.

*Award Amount*

Students with CGPA of 2.5 at a previous college - up to \$2000.00 of the semester tuition remaining after all other grant aid is applied.

Students with CGPA of 2.0-2.49 at a previous college - up to \$1500.00 of the semester tuition remaining after all other grant aid is applied.

*Application Procedure*

Scholarship eligibility and award amount will be determined by the Scholarship Committee. In order to be considered, applicant must complete the ASA College admissions and scholarship applications, meet with an ASA Admissions Advisor, and submit an essay describing his/her interest in the chosen program.
